Salford UCRC is launching a free welfare benefits take-up campaign so that everyone can claim their legally entitled benefits.

The Centre will give you both free advice and representation on all welfare benefit issues including:

Personal Independence Payments (PIP) which has replaced Disability Living Allowance (DLA). PIP can be paid to people aged between 16-65 with severe mobility problems or people who need help with their daily living due to long term illness or disability

Attendance Allowance (AA)
Income Support
Child/Working Tax Credit

Employment Support Allowance (ESA)
Jobseekers's Allowance
Council Tax/Housing benefit reviews
